It also offers a significant amount of space, providing up to 30.7 cubic feet with the rear seats upright. Drivers who choose to fold down the rear seats will get up to 60.1 cubic feet of space. If you're heading out on a vacation, this ride can be an excellent choice.

Kia Sorento

The cargo area starts with 12.6 cubic feet of volume with the back seats upright, which can be expanded by folding the third row for a comfortable 45 cubic feet. For the full volume, though, lower the second row, too, for up to 75.5 cubic feet of volume.

We also find that this Kia SUV offers an available turbocharged 2.5-liter engine that delivers 281 horsepower and 311 lb-ft of torque. This upgraded powertrain gives drivers a boost in their towing potential, too, with up to 3,500 pounds of towing capability.

As with the Kia Sportage, the Sorento also has an available all-wheel drive system, providing reliable handling on various road conditions. By using this system, the driver will be able to traverse gravel on a trail with ease.
